Dear Lions Clubs of District 2-E2

The District 2-E2 PDG/PCS Association is proud to announce the Annual Albert W. and Viola Brown Humanitarian Award. The award is to honor a Lion in the district who has given of him or herself through time, talents, and donations to the causes of humanitarian works in his/her community and the world. This award is named in honor of PDG Albert W. Brown and his wife Lion Viola who have contributed so much to the service of Lionism through the years. Last year the recipient was Lion Bob Parker nominated by Fort Worth Trinity Lions Club. The award is given to honor a great, longtime, grassroots Lion who might otherwise be overlooked. The award is NOT in competition with or a replacement for the MD-2 Lions Hall of Fame or the District Governor's Lion of the Year award.

The procedure for nominating a club member is fairly simple. The qualifications for candidacy are as follows:

1. Only a club may nominate a candidate. NO self-nominations are allowed.
2. Only one nomination per club per year.
3. The club will provide a resume, with picture of the candidate, outlining the candidate's qualifications and a short narrative explaining the reasons for the club's nomination of this Lion.
4. The candidate **MUST** have been a Lion for **at least 15 years** as of July 1, 2009.
5. The candidate must have held a District office, or served on an Entity Board (i.e. TLC, 2-E2 Organ & Eye Bank, DAC, J. C. Hyer Camp), or served as a District chairman or been a Cabinet member for **at least 5 years**. (Combined total for all these positions)
6. The candidate **CANNOT** have served as a District Governor. (**All PDGs are ineligible.**)

The time for you to consider nominating one of your club members for this award is **NOW** because the **cutoff date for submission is December 1, 2009**.

All nominations are to be submitted to the Chairman of the PDG/PCS Association Selection Committee: IPDG Don Yandell, 4701 County Road 707, Cleburne, TX 76031. Entries **MUST** be postmarked by December 1, 2009 to be considered. If you have questions, contact IPDG Don Yandell or PDG David Gramm.

All nominations received will be reviewed by the PDG/PCS Association Selection Committee and a recipient will be chosen from those nominations. The winning recipient will be announced at the 2010 Midwinter Conference, and the award will be presented at the Midwinter Conference Governor's Banquet.
